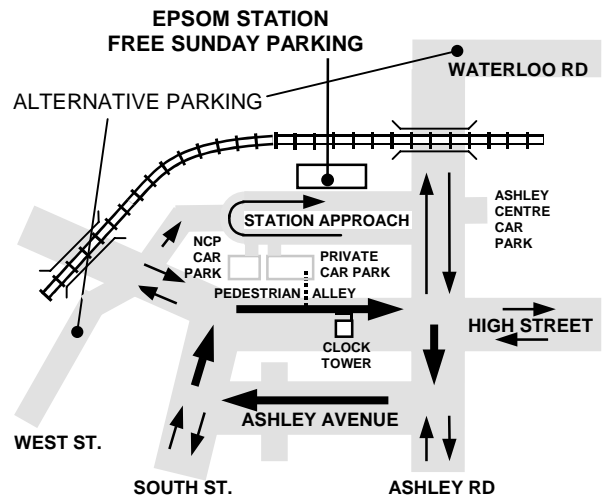
The garden is 300 yds walk from there. Note: no entrance for cars from A25.
